Adventure and collaboration are at the heart of violinist **Clara Kim**. By commissioning, premiering, and championing the works of living composers, she has quickly established herself at the forefront of her generation in the interpretation of contemporary music. Clara continues to actively premiere works through her solo and chamber music projects, and has received commissioning support from organizations such as Chamber Music America, The Koussevitzky Foundation, Concert Artists Guild, and Caramoor Center for Music and the Arts.

Clara is a recipient of the St. Botolph Club Foundation Emerging Artist Award and a first prize winner of the Cremona Solo Violin Competition, in addition to a first prize winner at the MPrize Chamber Arts and Concert Artists Guild Competitions as a member of the Argus Quartet. Significant appearances include Carnegie Hall, Jordan Hall, Lincoln Center's Alice Tully Hall, Merkin Hall, and Amsterdam's Concertgebouw.
